Dear Mr. President,

Today Venezuela is being subjected to a conflict generated and executed by a criminal system, which has destroyed the social, economic and political institutions, as well as the Venezuelan family in general. We are not suffering a conventional conflict! It is a transnational conflict, which will only cease when it is forcefully defeated.

The people of Venezuela have fought the criminal state from every possible trench, and finally the international community has a better understanding of the geopolitical dimension. The economic sanctions and constraints imposed on the regime have had favorable results. However, this non-conventional conflict has resulted in the emergence of a mafia network that provides the regime with media, financial and strategic resources. The regional threat shall persist in so far as the mafia and criminal groups are tolerated. They shall never be deterred by empty dialogues without conditions.

Most countries in the world no longer have doubts about the regime. Far from protecting the people from unnecessary suffering and death, the Maduro regime is responsible for a systematic attack against them. Therefore, those of us who are aware of the seriousness and risk of this conflict, understand the urgent need to raise our voice before the United States of America regarding the need to implement the international principle of **Responsibility to Protect (A / RES / 60/1, paragraph 139, UN)**. The R2P is applicable in view of the growing presence of crimes against humanity and threats to the people. To this day, at least seven crimes typified in the Rome Statute (OAS, 2018), have been ratified in Venezuela.

The Venezuelan Constitution, in its article 187, No. 11, regarding the powers of the National Assembly, backs this international principle. Already a group of Venezuelan citizens have asked the National Assembly to request the entrance of a **humanitarian peace mission** into the Country. This mission would provide assistance to the Venezuelan population, and also promote a definitive regime change, which would result in the extinction of the mafias and the protection of the population from crimes and tortures unleashed by Nicolas Maduro's tyranny.

Venezuela needs the support of the United States of America and the democracies of the western world. Venezuelans can no longer defeat the regime alone! Therefore, those of us who wish to be part of the free world and live without oppression, ask your government to submit this request to the corresponding international entities in order to protect the Venezuelan people from the criminal state that rules them.
